Brownhelm Township is located in Lorain County, 20 miles west of Cleveland. Figures show Lorain County with a population of 312,964 and Brownhelm Township with a population of 7,618.

#### **LORAIN COUNTY**


Lorain County is a county located in the northeastern portion of the U.S. State of Ohio. As of the 2020 census, the population was 312,964. The county has grown exponentially over the years since being founded in 1822 after merging portions of adjacent counties. Being the fourth largest county in Ohio by area with 923 square miles, multiple major interstates pass through including I-80 (Ohio Turnpike), I-90, and I-480.
